When: Wednesday, June 15

What: Spend all day in the National Museum of the US Air Force.

Details:

9:00 am: Arrive at the museum, drive/carpool.

The museum features more than 350 aerospace vehicles and missiles and thousands of artifacts amid more than 19 acres of indoor exhibit space. The outdoor Air Park is located just past the employee parking lot outside the main museum complex. It features aircraft exhibits, including a C-17 Globemaster and an AC-130 Hercules; the World War II 8th Air Force Control Tower and Nissen Huts; and a playground.
